DRESS CODE





General rules

- All members and guests, when on Club property, (Club House, parking lot, golf course and practice range), must be properly dressed.
- "Safari", "rugby", "jogging" and "cargo" pants are not permitted.
- Jeans and denim clothing of any colour are not allowed.
- Clothing bearing the logo or colours of any organization not closely related to golf is not acceptable.
- Only golf shoes with soft spikes are accepted on the course. In addition, it is forbidden to wear "basketball" style sneakers on all Club property.
- Caps may not be worn backwards



The use of cell phones for voice functions is prohibited on all Club property except for telephone booths and moderately in locker rooms. Any form of ringing is strictly prohibited everywhere. Sending and reading e-mails and text messages are allowed.



Additional rules specific to gentlemen

- Golf shirts must have a collar. Turtlenecks are acceptable. At all times shirt tails must be tucked in. T-shirts are not permitted.
- Hats, visors and caps may not be worn in the clubhouse or on the veranda.
- Bermuda shorts are permitted at a MAXIMUM of three (3) inches above the knee. They are to be worn with golf knee-length socks or with ankle socks no higher than the top of the ankle bone. Capri pants (3/4 leght) are not permitted.
- Sandals may not be worn on Club property.

Additional rules specific to ladies

- Shirts with collar may be worn with or without sleeves and t-shirts must have sleeves. These must be worn tucked in.
- The polo shirt designed to be worn outside pants, skirts and bermudas must cover the hips without falling under the buttocks and may not reveal skin when swinging.
