OFFICIAL PROGRAMME

Tuesday, September 12

REGISTRATION

Participants registration and their guests will take place in the lobby of the Château Frontenac between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.

OFFICIAL OPENING

Citadelle de Québec

The official opening shall take place on the parade square at the Citadelle de Québec in the presence of the Regimental Band and the soldiers of the 22^e Régiment decked out in their scarlet regimental dress. At this occasion, the band will play for the very first time an Anthem to the Royal Clubs especially composed for them by Mr. Steve Barakatt, an internationally acclaimed pianist and composer, who, in 2009, has composed the official UNICEF International Anthem "Lullaby". This ceremony will be held at 4:00 p.m.

Welcome reception

The official opening will be followed by a welcome reception on the terrace of the governor general summer residence located on the heights of Cap Diamant. This reception will be held between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Dress code

At this occasion, the dress code suggested for participants is the colors of their respective club. Cocktail dress and informal attire are recommended for the guests.

At this period of the year, it is strongly recommended to bring warm clothing as temperature may be cooler at evening.



Wednesday, September 13

PARTICIPANTS

For participants and guests who will like to play a practice round, starting time will be available between 7:00 a.m and 1:00 p.m.

GUESTS

A tour of the Old Quebec will take place at 2:00 p.m. Situated in the heart of the historic *Cité de Québec*, founded in 1608 by Champlain, Old Quebec has been designated a World Heritage treasure by UNESCO. It should be noted that Old Quebec is the only walled city north of Mexico.

The evening will be free in order to allow participants and guests to relax, try and taste Quebec's gastronomy.

Thursday, September 14

PARTICIPANTS

Brunch

A brunch will be served at the Club between 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.

Opening ceremonies

The ceremonies marking the beginning of the gathering between Royal clubs will begin at 11:00 a.m. Tribute will be paid to the aboriginal peoples by a troupe of traditional Huron-Wendat nations.

First round

A shotgun is scheduled to start at 12:30 p.m. in order to let the participants meet after the round. The first round will be played on the Quebec course.

Stableford is the chosen format. Scores obtained on each hole shall be calculated as follows:



Score	Points
More than 2 strokes or no score	0
2 strokes over par	1
1 stroke over par	2
par	3
1 stroke under par	4
2 strokes under par	5
3 strokes under par	6

Player's handicap factor shall be added to the points obtained for his round.

GUESTS

A visit of the Plains of Abraham is planned to attend exhibitions *Battles 1759-1760* and have an *Animated Guided Tour*. As for *Battles 1759-1760*, guests shall experience the siege of Quebec and the 1759 and 1760 battles with authenticity, as if they were there, thanks to a "multimedia presentation of innovative quality". As for the *Animated Guide Tour*, they shall discover the Quebec City Martello Towers and one of the world's most prestigious urban parks with General Wolfe.

Cocktail and dinner

A cocktail will be held between 6:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. for the participants and their guests. The cocktail will be followed by a BBQ under the marquee.

Friday, September 15

PARTICIPANTS

Brunch

A brunch will be served at the Club between 7:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m.

Final round

The final round will be played on the Royal course. It will also be a shotgun, starting at 9:00 a.m. The format will be the same as the day before, which is stableford.



Determination of the winning club

The winning club will be determined by adding to the points obtained by two players representing a club. Given the fact that a club may have less than two or more than two players, the total points obtained by the representatives of this club shall be calculated as follows.

Points calculation method for determining the winning club	Points
One player	Number of points obtained by the player representing his club multiplied by 2.
Two players	Number of points obtained by the two players.
Three players	Number of points obtained by the three players representing their club divided by three and multiplied by 2.
Four players	Number of points obtained by the four players representing their club divided by four and multiplied by two
More than four players	Number of points obtained by the number of players representing their club divided by the same number of players and multiplied by 2.

GUESTS

CLOSING CEREMONY

The closing ceremony will be held at 5:30 p.m. at which the Royal Cup will be awarded to the team representing the winning club.

Cocktail and closing dinner

A cocktail will take place starting at 6:00 p.m. followed by the closing banquet.

Dress code

The dress code suggested for participants is the colors of the club. Cocktail dress and informal attire are recommended the guests.

It is strongly recommended to bring warm garments as temperature may be cooler at evening at this period of the year.
